#### **Spotlight: Edmundo Sanchez and Robert Kronon**

During their bike route, correctional officers Edmundo Sanchez and Robert Kronon noticed an elderly woman sitting outside the Cook County Jail.

Thanks to Officer Sanchez and Officer Kronon's collaboration with the Chicago Police Department, it was quickly discovered that the woman had dementia and had been reported missing 24 hours prior.

She was <u>safely</u> reunited with her caregiver.

#### **Spotlight: Officer William Hoefler and Officer Samuel Suffern**

Officers William Hoefler and Samuel Suffern pulled over a car for a traffic violation and found marijuana, an open container of alcohol, and a canvas bag containing 68 clear bags of suspected marijuana. The total amount of drugs weighed more than 3 pounds.

Sheriff's Police also located a loaded, semi-automatic handgun concealed in the driver's clothing, and more than \$1,200 in cash was recovered. The two men involved have bails set at \$200,000 and \$50,000 respectively.

#### **Spotlight: Officer Eugene Butler**

Officer Eugene Butler, a trained hostage negotiator who also has crisis intervention training, responded to a call regarding a 40-year-old man from Park Forest who was feeling despondent and suicidal on northbound IL-394.

Officer Butler convinced the man not to jump, and the man was taken by ambulance to an area hospital for observation.

#### **Spotlight: Street Crime Suppression Team**

The Team took an offender into custody after finding a loaded gun with a laser mount in a backpack that had been reported stolen from Jackson, Mississippi. They also learned that the offender, age 37, was out on bond on an unlawful use of a weapon charge and that he had a previous felony conviction for delivery of a controlled substance.

The offender has been charged with unlawful use of a weapon by a felon, possession of a weapon without a Firearm Owner's Identification (FOID) card and possession of firearm ammunition without a FOID. His bond in this case was set at \$100,000 during his March 23 court appearance at the George N. Leighton Criminal Court Building. He also was ordered held without bond for a violation of bail bond.


